## **Payment** So ricing

- Students (under age of 23): \$2248.00
- Adults (age 23 and over): \$2473.00

\*The above prices were locked until 9/29. After, the increase depends on the market and can rise on average \$25-\$50.

- No payments go through CPS or ACS.
- All payments will be made through the Explorica portal.
- 3 different types of payment plans are available (in full, monthly, manual custom).



# **Hotel Accomodations**

- Students are paired 4 to a room.
- Student rooms will have 2 queen-size beds.
- Students will be paired with students.
- Rooming will be decided by (1) student choice and (2) gender.
- Adult prices are higher because they have to upgrade to a different type of room to be paired with 1 other adult.
- If parents want to room with their child, that can be accommodated by paying an extra fee of \$180.
