Dear Parents/Guardians,

It's November and it is officially sweater season! As we continue to see the temperatures drop, please make sure that your child have appropriate clothing for their commute to school and for recess. I hope the cold stays away as long as possible, but each day is an adventure.

It is hard to believe that we have completed the first quarter of the school year. I hope you had the opportunity to meet with your child teacher(s) on Quarter 1 Parent Conference Day. Our records indicate that 89% of parents met with their child's teacher. In collaboration with Bright Star and Network 9, the top 10 schools in Network 9 with the highest percentage of parents who attended Parent Conference Day will receive a school-wide pizza party. If our school wins, parents will be notified on REMIND. All Quarter 1 Report Cards that were not picked-up on Parent Conference Day were sent home with your child on October 30th.

Attendance Incentive (November)

We are now in the eleventh week of the 2023-2024 school year. It is imperative that students attend school daily and on



time. Students who attend school regularly and on time have been shown to achieve higher levels than students who do not have regular attendance. One of the most powerful ways to prepare a child for success in life is through regular school attendance. The early elementary years from Kindergarten through third grade are extremely important in a child's emotional and academic growth. Primary students must master foundational skills such as early counting, number sense, phonological awareness, phonics knowledge, and decoding skills, all of which

contribute to the development of fluent reading.

All students who are present at school for the entire day for the month of November will receive an Attendance Incentive on Friday, December 1, 2023.

Student Arrival and Early Dismissal



It is imperative that students arrive to school on time at 8:45 a.m. When students arrive late to school, they miss valuable instructional minutes. If it is necessary for your child to leave school prior to the dismissal time of 3:45 p.m., please note: **Early Dismissals will not be granted after 3:15 p.m.**

No School Days



There will be no school on Friday, November 10th. It is Veteran's Day. There will be no school on November 20th-24th. It is Thanksgiving Break. School will resume on Monday, November 27th at 8:45 a.m.

Academic Check-In (5th-8th Grades)

Academic Check-Ins will be held on Monday, November 6, 2023 for all 5th-8th grade students. The Academic Check-Ins allow students the time to check their grades, speak with their teachers about their grades, missing assignments, make-up work, and set-goals prior to the distribution of progress reports and report cards. Students are provided with pertinent academic information from the school counselor and administrators.

Physical Examination and Immunization Requirements

There are still over 50 students who are out-of-medical compliance. Parents are reminded that physical examination and immunization requirements for Chicago Public School students are as follows: Students entering **kindergarten**, **sixth**, and



ninth grade are required to submit proof of physical examination and current immunizations to their local school by **October 15**th **of each year**. Out-of-medical compliance notification were emailed to parents on September 10, 2023 and a hard copy distributed to parents on Parent Conference Day. If you have already submitted a complete Certificate of Child Health Examination Form, please accept our appreciation. If you have not met this requirement, please submit a completed Certificate of Child Health Examination Form to Nurse Reed. Students entering kindergarten, second, and sixth grade must have their dental examination completed by May 15th of each school year. If your child has not

received the required examination and your family does not have healthcare insurance, please contact the Chicago Public School Children and Family Benefit Unit (CFBU). You may be eligible for Allkids or Family Care. Contact CFBU at 773-553-1809.

GoCPS Kindergarten Applications

Pre-K students who attend a school other than their neighborhood school will need to re-apply to stay for kindergarten. On October 20th, families of CPS Pre-K students who do not have an automatic continuing seat at their current school and who have not yet submitted a GoCPS application were notified via email that they must participate in the GoCPS

application process if they are interested in having their child attend the same school for kindergarten. The <u>GoCPS</u> <u>application</u> will close on **November 9th at 5pm.** Families can apply online or via phone at (773) 553-2060.

GoCPS High School Application

Because of the adjusted timeline for High School Admission Testing, the GoCPS re-ranking deadline is being extended until December 1st, 2023 at 5 pm. The application deadline remains November 9th, 2023 at 5 p.m. Families must submit an initial application with their choices by the November 9th deadline, but will be able to re-rank their choices until December 1st.
