# **8<sup>th</sup> Grade Activity Participation Requirements**

## ***Academics & Attendance:***

All students are required to maintain good attendance, demonstrate responsibility, have passing grades of "C" or better in all subjects and show good behavior. A student who exhibits unsatisfactory conduct in class as reflected in quarterly grade reports or who has misconducts and/or failing to follow reasonable directions in class/school will be ineligible to participate.

## ***Behavior:***

Discipline issues will cause your child not to be a part of a monthly activity. Should your child receive 3 discipline slips in one month he/she will not be permitted to participate in that month's activity. Your child would be eligible for the next month's activity as long as he/she does not receive 3 more discipline slips.

Should your child receive an Out-of-School Suspension he/she will be ineligible to participate in two consecutive 8<sup>th</sup> grade activities.

**Funds will not be refunded. All funds paid will be applied to the next month's activity.**
