Re: Teacher directives to refrain from forwarding work to students who do not attend class without approval.

Hello Carnegie Professionals,

There are a number of parents who have elected to keep their child(ren) home due to COVID-19 and have requested that the teacher upload classwork to Google Classroom or have asked to pick up hard copies assignments for their child(ren). All students are required to attend school in person. The district did not offer parents a choice for remote or in-person learning for the 2021-22 school year. The district ONLY offers students remote learning for the following reasons:

- *if the student test positive for COVID-19.
- *if the class has been quarantined by CPS Office of Student Health & Wellness (OSHW).
- *if the student was exposed to COVID-19 (i.e. close contact) and required to self-isolate by the CPS Office of Student Health & Wellness (OSHW).

If any of the above circumstances occur, you will be notified via email from me (Principal Pollard) with all pertinent information and next steps. **Teachers are not to provide hard copies of assignments or upload classwork in Google Classroom for students whose parents choose not to send their child(ren) to school in person.** Parents have the choice to apply to CPS Virtual Academy or Homeschool their child(ren). If your parents have any questions concerning remote learning, you are to direct them to AP Roberson or me.
